# LODGE LAYOUT





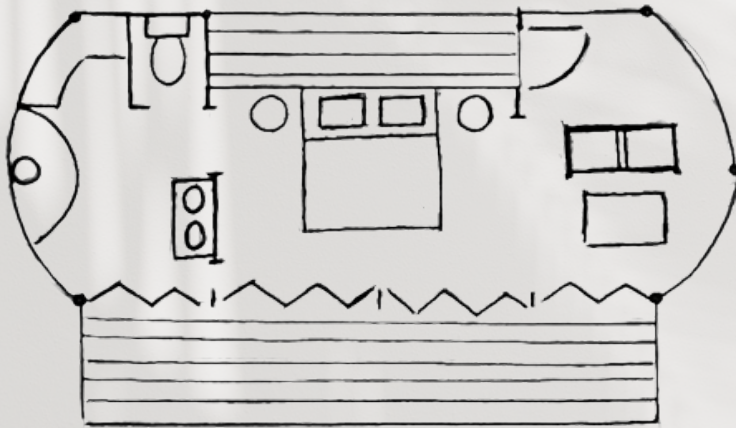
# ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

## BEACH BUNGALOWS

There are currently three beach bungalows that sleep two guests each. The beach bungalows are open plan design with en-suite bathrooms. They are placed amongst the flora and dunes with beautiful concertina glass doors leading out onto a small deck. Enjoy being immersed in the island with the fresh open breeze and view in your private bungalow.

### BEACH BUNGALOW ROOM LAYOUT



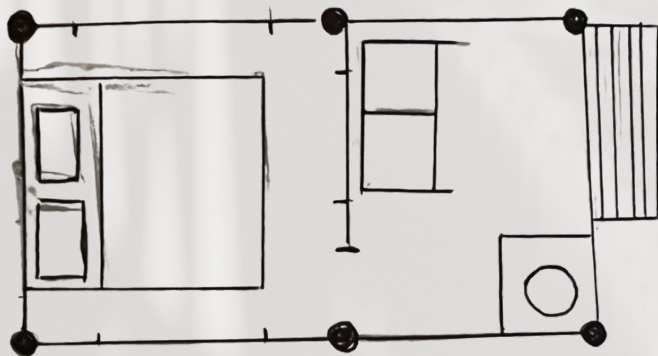


# CASTAWAY TENTED VILLAGE

The castaway styled camp sleeps a maximum of 22 guests and can be exclusively booked by groups. The tented camp consists of 11 small stilted units made out of a permanent wooden structure, canvas walls and a fixed roof. Each unit has two three quarter size beds with linen and bath towels provided, a basin, solar powered fan and a plug point for charging electronics.

There are two big communal ablutions for ladies and gentlemen, each have 3 toilets, 3 showers, all with doors for privacy and a basin area.

# LODGE INFORMATION

## CENTRAL AREA

The central area consists of the reception, manager's office, a small library/shop, kitchen, Zenga Restaurant, restrooms, Zenga Zenga bar, pool and relaxing area. Please note there is Wi-Fi available in the central area for guests to use,

## ZENGA RESTAURANT

The Zenga restaurant is open to day visitors passing by but bookings must be made in advance if meals are required as getting supplies from mainland will need to be ordered in advance.

For guests staying at Zenguelemo, breakfast and lunches can be ordered off the menus and dinners are set.

Rates include three meals daily, snacks and extra meals can be provided for an additional cost.

Any dietary requirements can be discussed before your stay. Please kindly note due to our location all meal options are subject to availability.

Meal times are strictly as follows:

Breakfast served from 7:00 am - 9:30 am

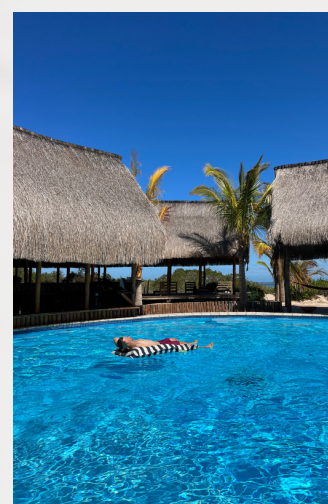
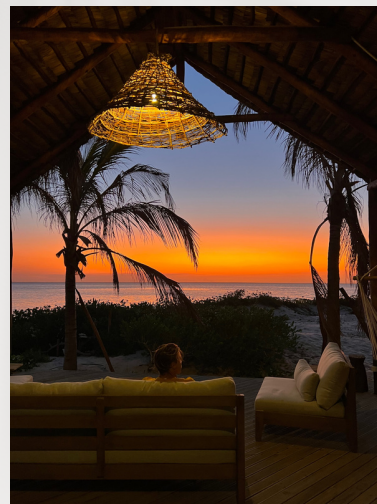
Lunch served from 12:00 pm - 14:30 pm

## ZENGA ZENGA BAR

The Zenga Zenga bar is open from 11:00 am to 20:00pm. Please be advised that alcoholic drinks will not be served to anyone under the age of 18 years old. A drinks tab can be open for the duration of your stay but must be settled before checkout.

Please note that guests are not permitted to bring their own alcohol to our lodge and if for any reason guests decide otherwise there will be a corkage fee of US\$100 per day surcharge.





# LODGE INFORMATION

## POOL AND RELAXING AREA

### HOUSE RULES FOR THE POOL:

All children must be supervised by a responsible adult whilst swimming and using the relaxing area.

No running and diving into and around the pool is permitted.

No glassware is permitted in the pool.

No smoking is permitted in the pool area.

Please shower to remove any sand before using the pool or dip feet in foot baths provided.

## HOUSEKEEPING

The communal bathrooms will be cleaned at least twice daily but we encourage all users to respect the area as it is being shared.

Please be mindful of the environment when using the towels. We provide a set of bath towels for your stay and if you would like a fresh towel kindly request one from reception.

There is a laundry service available to guests, please note there is an additional cost.

Smaller items (shirts, tops, skirts, shorts, underwear and short dresses) are US\$3.00 per item.

larger items (jerseys, long tops, trousers, long pants) are US\$6.00 per item.

## CHECKING IN & OUT INFORMATION

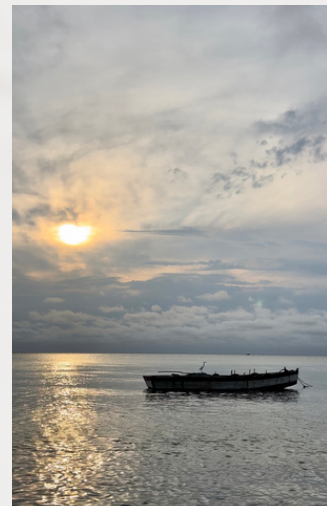
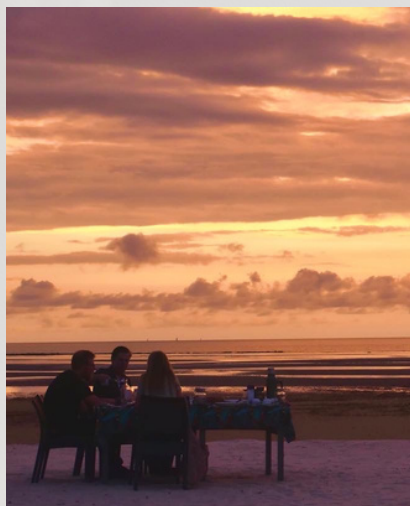
Checking in time is 14:00 pm.

This is the earliest guests can check in as our team needs to sanitise and prepare for your arrival after previous guests.

Please note on arrival day dinner is included in rates but if guests would like to arrive earlier and have lunch it is an additional meal and the cost is US\$25 per person.

Checking out time is 10:00 am.

Please note breakfast is included on day of departure and if guests would like to stay for lunch it will be an additional meal and the cost is US\$25 per person.

## WILDLIFE

Located within the Bazaruto Archipelago National Park, the lodge surroundings are home to a variety of bird life, mammals and reptiles which include: red duiker, samango monkeys (who are shy and are not pests) and of course some snakes. Please be aware when walking on boardwalks and if you encounter any wildlife keep calm and respect their space.



# GENERAL INFORMATION

## MALARIA INFORMATION & PRECAUTION

Mozambique is a risk area for malaria. High risk months are from September to May. Before traveling to Mozambique, please ask your local pharmacy or doctor about medical prevention. Please note that no preventative measure is 100% effective. Should flu like symptoms and signs such as body pain, headache and fever develop around seven days or longer after your visit, please seek medical treatment for malaria.

Preventative measures:

wearing long sleeve shirts and trousers in the evenings and apply mosquito repellent to any exposed skin every 4 to 6 hours.

We provide mosquito nets in the beach bungalows and fans, as well as mosquito gauze in the castaway units. Please ensure to pack mosquito repellent for your stay, otherwise you can buy some at the lodge.

Treatment:

Malaria treatment consists of a three day course of Coartem ( antiviral medication) and is more effective when taken together with a course of doxycycline (broad spectrum antibiotic) for five days.

## RECOMMENDED CHECKLIST

This is a recommended packing list for your stay at Zenguelemo Lodge

- Suncream
- Insect / Mosquito Repellent ( Peaceful Sleep)
- Personal Toiletries | toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo & conditioner, soap, razor.
- Snorkelling gear | this is available to rent if you do not have your own
- Medication | any personal medication, if you are bringing children please also ensure you have a basic medical aid for them.
- A hat and cap
- Sunglasses
- Shoes | we recommend at least one pair of slops/sandals as boardwalks can get hot. If you are keen on hiking around the Island then a pair of track shoes is required.
- Swimwear ( a swim shirt is useful for sun protection)
- A water bottle ( we have borehole water that is drinkable but would like to minimise the amount of plastic bottles)
- Adaptor for charging your devices ( we have type F European two prong plugs installed)
- Beach shoes ( we do have an in-house reef with rocks that can be explored but we do advise that shoes are used)
- Sleep eye mask (blinkers) for those who need pitch black nights to sleep.
- A carry bag | preferably waterproof, to carry valuables and personal items for boat activities.
